We're now inviting expressions of interest from Members who might like to be Ward Managers for the Branch. We need about 30 people to build a grass-roots network of volunteers: the idea is that, when an election comes up (whether for a seat on a local community council, for example, or on the Senedd itself) each WM can call on half-a-dozen friends and helpers to deliver leaflets and similar in their area.

Being a WM is also a fun, social role: you might hold a few informal get-togethers (coffee mornings, pub drinks, summer BBQs etc — whatever you prefer), where potential new Members can come and learn more about Reform UK. You won't have to do this alone — I can put you in touch with existing Members and Supporters in your ward, and help you reach out to new ones. I can also come myself to your first event(s) to help get your group off to a good start.

As a WM you would only be asked to organise events and invite people you are comfortable with. (If you are comfortable, your guests will be comfortable.) You can hold events as often (or not) as you like — although one meeting every five or six weeks, say, might be a reasonable minimum. This personal, organic approach is the best way to build the trust and teams we need.
